

## Conkers

Conkers is a seven-bed homely residential setting for adults who have profound and multiple learning disabilities located on our Mirfield site, it forms part of the Meadows development.

Each bedroom is en-suite with shared kitchen and lounge areas. Conkers also boasts a music room, featuring iMuse technology, which helps people create pieces of art through soundwaves. All seven rooms lead out into a shared patio area, so that the people who live here can enjoy the surrounding garden areas. Conkers give the adults creative control over their individual patio space which can be renovated and themed to represent them.

The adults who live with us have access to lots of social activities including attending the pub or cafe for nice meals, going to the park to feed the ducks, and attending sporting and music events. Our staff are always thinking of fun activities and also work alongside Hollybank's in-house therapies team.

The vast majority of people we support use wheelchairs to move around and communicate non–verbally. Our services are wheelchair accessible, although vary in layout.

Each service is unique, we provide support that is individual to each person, and promote full participation in our residential environments such as involving adults in decoration, furnishing, and we also promote utilising communal areas to meet preferred collective benefits.
